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# BIG AND BULKY

Across almost every designer, the Fall 2023/Winter 2024 season showcases many looks which are layered and heavy. There is a semblance of androgyny to this style, as oversized silhouettes disguise the model's natural figure, putting more of an emphasis on over-exaggerated garment sizes.



# COLORS

The oversized trend leans towards more traditional fall and winter colors. Thus, we see lots of dark and warm shades. This creates visual weight and adds to the heaviness of these already intense looks.

### HIGH VISIBILITY

One of the most popular statement colors in this trend is yellow. This particular shade is a popular pop of vibrancy, but more muted mustard-toned hues are also popular.

### DOE

A classic for the fall season, this light brown shade looks clean and traditional independently and can also act as a nice base for pops of color.

### HOT FUDGE

A rich, chocolate brown shade, this is a very popular staple color for the season which helps to add depth to any look.

### **BURNT SIENNA**

Shades of red are popular this season, and this warm lighter shade tends to add subtle warmth to layered looks.

### RED DHALIA

A common complement to the aforementioned "Burnt Sienna," this darker shade adds warmth and depth to any fall look.

### ECLIPSE

A blue so dark it's nearly black, this is a popular, rich shade for more formal garments such as pants or blazers.

# TEXTILES/FABRICS

To create these bulky looks, heavier fabrics such as wool and leather are popular this season. Traditional fall and winter fabrics, such as cashmere and flannel, are also seen throughout the runway providing warmth and comfort.



### LEATHER

Leather is a classic fall and winter material. This season, leather can be seen on garments from oversized, boxy leather jackets to snake print leather skirts.




### WOOL

Wool provides warmth and is a particularly heavy fabric, making it a common choice for blazers and outerwear this season.



### CASHMERE

A luxurious, soft fabric, cashmere is popular among high end designers. Cashmere sweaters and scarfs were stacked atop one another across nearly every runway this season.



### TWEED

Tweed is a woven fabric that comes in a variety of styles. This is a common fabric used to add texture in outerwear.



### FLANNEL

A popular fall fabric, different weaves of flannel can be seen across the runway, typically in outerwear.



### DENIM

The runway this season has taken denim far beyond classic bluejeans. Denim dresses, jackets, and matching sets are common across the runway and all tend to share a boxy, oversized fit.

This trend is largely marked by the common, boxy silhouette that a variety of designers showcased on the runway. Blazers and wide-shouldered jackets were seen on both men and women in very modern designs. These styles lended towards a unisex and androgynous vibe in many collections.

## A SEE-THROUGH SEASON

In most Fall 2023/Winter 2024 runway shows, a clear theme that emerges is sheer clothing. From mesh paneling in dresses to entirely see-through tops, designers are embracing the low-coverage look. In part, this may stem from an increasing appreciation of natural beauty and showing the female body with complete transparency.



# COLORS

The sheer trend is often utilized in more formal or night-out looks. Thus, it is often done in chic basic colors like cream or black and often also can be seen with brighter, more striking colors like red or cobalt blue.

### TENDER PEACH

A warmer variation on cream perfect for the fall months and a common complement to warmer colors.

### SILVER BIRCH

Many transparent looks feature metallic shades. This lighter variation of the classic metallic, silver, is another popular choice this season for chic edgy looks.

### SILVER

Beyond metallic colors, which are popular this season, many garments feature gems or metal textiles in an eye-catching silver shade to add an element of luxury to the look.

### BLACK

Chic, sexy, and dramatic, black is a classic choice for night-out and formal looks.

### ELMO RED

This vibrant, true red is one of the main statement colors for the Fall 2023/Winter 2024 season. Some runway looks, such as Gucci's RTW show, feature entirely sheer monochrome outfits in this shade.


### COBALT BLUE

Another popular statement color this season, cobalt blue is a flattering and vibrant shade that is commonly being used as a pop of color in many sheer looks.

# TEXTILES/FABRICS

Naturally, the popular fabrics in this trend tend to be low coverage and transparent. Thin materials like mesh and lace are frequently used to create paneling in sexy, delicate designs while others, such as chiffon and tulle, are layered to create volume while still maintaining a see-through appearance.





### MESH

Mesh is a fairly flexible textile, making it a very common tool in seethrough designs. From mesh paneling to entirely mesh outfits, this textile leaves little coverage and pairs well with other textiles.

### FISHNET

Commonly known through fishnet tights in edgier looks, fishnet fabric has made an appearance on the runway this season, often amidst the neo-punk trend that has proven popular recently.

### CHAINMAIL

Heavy hardware was common on the runway this season and it isn't limited to jewelry. Chainmail dresses, tops, and skirts created a daring and edgy appearance in many designer shows.



### LACE

Lace has been popular throughout the entire history of fashion, but this season lots of lace garments could be seen leaving little to the imagination. This fabric creates a feminine yet sexy appearance.

### CHIFFON

Chiffon, a lighter fabric, tends to create a more airy and luxurious appearance. This is commonly used in dresses or drapings on tops.

### TULLE

Another feminine and delicate fabric, tulle is often used in skirts and embroilery to add volume with little weight.

Many of the styles and silhouettes in the see-through trend help contribite to an edgy, sexy appearance for night-out and formal looks. In tune with the low-coverage fabrics, cuts this season are often quite revealing.
